5.3.3.1 Sanitary waste, nitrate-nitrogen and other chemicals of concern – new text to preamble to clarify sources of nitrogen

Standard 5.3.3.1.1 Suffolk County Sanitary Code Article 6 compliance - *clarification and compliance*

Standard 5.3.3.1.2 Sewage treatment plant discharge – *removed term “denitrification”*

Standard 5.3.3.1.3 Suffolk County Sanitary Code Articles 7 and 12 – *no change except for adding titles of existing regulations; relocated Guideline 5.3.3.2.1*

Standard 5.3.3.1.4 Commercial and industrial compliance with the Suffolk County Sanitary Code – *no change except for adding titles of existing regulations; relocated Guideline 5.3.3.12.1*

Standard 5.3.3.1.5 Nitrate-nitrogen (*presently a Guideline*)

** The change of this Guideline to a Standard continues its applicability to be mandatory only for projects which fall into one of the categories of being a DRS, is located in a CRA, or is a project which the Commission has “asserted jurisdiction,” and continues the fact that even now as a standard it is still not required to be applied to other development projects in the CGA that do not fall into one of the prior categories.*

**Clarification to include “non-residential” equivalent.*

5.3.3.3 Wellhead and groundwater protection

Standard 5.3.3.3.1 Significant discharges and public supply well locations – *new text to incorporate the use of source water supply information*

Standard 5.3.3.3.2 Private well protection (*presently a Guideline*) – *4/17/13 worksession, Commission achieved consensus to not proceed with change to standard and to leave language as it currently exists.*

5.3.3.4 Wetlands, surface waters and stormwater runoff

Standard 5.3.3.4.1 Nondisturbance buffers – *4/17/13 worksession, Commission achieved consensus on change to incorporate additional non-disturbance buffer language to existing standard and make certain other language revisions.*

Standard 5.3.3.4.2 Wild, Scenic and Recreational Rivers Act compliance – *No change except to add term “development” for clarity, and submission of materials for compliance*

Standard 5.3.3.4.3 Stormwater recharge – *Relation of prior Standard 5.3.3.5.1 and clarification regarding off site discharge*

Standard 5.3.3.4.4 Reduction of Impervious Surfaces – *New Standard with clarification*

Standard 5.3.3.4.5 Natural recharge, drainage, ponds (*presently a Guideline*)- *Combines former related Guidelines 5.3.3.5.2, 5.3.3.5.3, 5.3.3.5.4 and restates as a uniform Standard*

Standard 5.3.3.4.6 Soil erosion and stormwater runoff control during construction (*presently a Guideline*) – *Replacement for prior Guideline 5.3.3.5.5 Stormwater runoff*
