Have fun at Wertheim National Wildlife Refuge in Shirley! Spend part of your day exploring the wildlife on the nature trails, see what lives in and on the Carmans River, observe the Central Pine Barrens ecosystem and experience your National Wildlife Refuge! **This is a hands-on, interactive summer camp.**

Due to COVID 19, camp this season will be adapted to keep everyone safe, healthy, and still have fun!

You will be provided unique learning opportunities such as:

- Marine and environmental science, including being part of an ongoing citizen science experiment related to Carmans River water quality
- Animal tracking and scavenger hunts
- Inter-active, hands-on environmental science activities
- Nature discoveries

The same session will repeat over six weeks: You choose session A or B.

The first three sessions are for campers 6 – 9 years old:

1. June 28 – July 2 **A is BookED**
2. July 5 – July 9 **A IS BookED**
3. July 12 – July 16

The last three sessions are for campers 10 – 12 years old:

4. July 19 – July 23
5. July 26 – July 30
6. August 9- August 13
