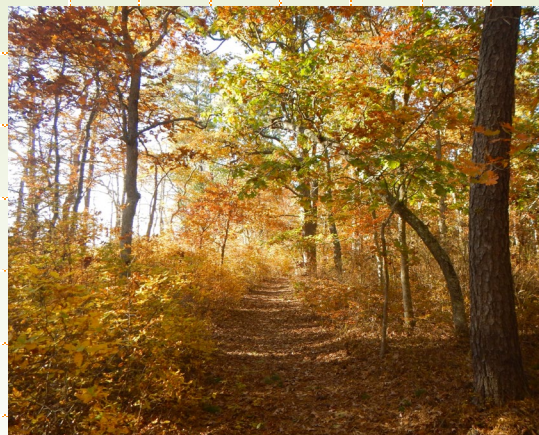

The Pine Barrens is home to fascinating plant species adapted to sandy, nutrient-poor soil



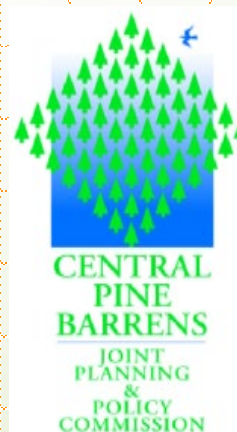
Robert Cushman Murphy County Park
