- Number 200-529-5-36. It's .09 acres in the A5 6
- 7 residence zoning district. The staff report is
- 8 Exhibit A. And I submitted Exhibits from A to
- 9 P for the record.
- 10 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: Uh-huh.
- 11 Okay.
- 12 (Whereupon, Staff Exhibits A through P
- 13 were received in evidence as of this
- 14 date.)
- 15 MR. TVERDYY: So exhibit -- exhibit --
- 16 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: Go through
- 17 each of the exhibits for us.
- 18 MR. TVERDYY: So this is the exhibits
- 19 (indicating).
- 20 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: Yup.
- 21 MR. TVERDYY: This is -- so the staff
- 22 report is Exhibit A.
- 23 Exhibit B is 2011 -- no I'm sorry, '18
- 24 Town of Brookhaven Suffolk County Tax Map album
- 25 page.

- 3 MR. TVERDYY: It shows the subject
- 4 parcel.
- 5 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: Uh-huh.
- 6 MR. TVERDYY: And in Exhibit C, we
- 7 have an aerial of the general area where the
- 8 parcel is.
- 9 And the next exhibit, you will see the
- 10 parcel that has more accurate pertinent
- 11 information of the public parcel.
- 12 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: Okay.
- 13 MR. TVERDYY: And so the next exhibits
- 14 are practically identical to the exhibits from
- 15 the -- the earlier hearing.
- 16 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: So photos;
- 17 right.
- 18 MR. MILAZZO: So that's what's wrong,
- 19 because remember, we're going to have two
- 20 separate records.

- 18 MS. HARGRAVE: H shows the wetlands in
- 19 the vicinity of the project site.
- 20 And I is the study area map.
- 21 And J is the map of the study area
- 22 from 1994, okay, and it's with an aerial just
- 23 showing the development of that area in 1994.
- 24 And K is the zoning of the study area
- which shows A5. 25

- 2 MR. TVERDYY: Thank you, Julie. And I
- 3 can take over from here.
- 4 Approximately 35 parcels in the Core
- 5 is in this study area, half-a-mile radius are
- protected through the conservation easement. 6
- 7 And they can encompass approximately 120 acres,
- 8 and they generated up to 100 Pine Barrens
- 9 Credits. All previously issued LOIs from 2010,
- 10 and 2015 and 2018, I'm sorry, '18 as an
- 11 Exhibit L, and allocation is .1 Credit.
- 12 On September the 6th, 2016, the parcel
- 13 was sold to Henry Dittmer by Henry Dittmer to
- 14 James Eagan and Henry Dittmer, and the deed is
- 15 in Exhibit M.
- 16 On September 14, 2016, the Commission
- 17 received a request from the applicant's
- 18 representative, Richard Scheyer, for an appeal
- 19 of the 2015 LOI for the subject parcel, and the
- applicants were seeking 1 Pine Barrens Credit. 20
- Mr. Scheyer stated in his letter to the 21
- 22 Commission which is Exhibit N, that the subject
- 23 parcel is similar in situation as a parcel
- 24 owned by the Woodstock Company with a tax map
- number 200-5293-35. And you can see the 25

- location of this parcel in Exhibit C up on the 2
- 3 aerial. It's outlined in red.
- 4 The -- that parcel received an
- increase in allocation from a .1 to 1 5
- 6 Pine Barrens Credit, as per Commission
- 7 resolution of June 1998, and which is
- 8 Exhibit P. The resolution says that parcel was
- 9 granted a revision of Credits allocation for
- 10 the reason that he had single and separate
- 11 status, and they had received permission
- 12 for the construction of the road and
- 13 single-family's house.
- On November 15th, 2016, applicant's 14
- 15 adjourned the public hearing for this subject
- 16 parcel. And on August 22nd, 2018, the
- 17 Commission received an LOI renewal application,
- 18 and request from the applicant's letter of
- 19 interpretation appeal for the subject parcel.
- 20 And this letter is Exhibit O.
- 21 So this is all we have in terms of the
- 22 new exhibits. If you any questions?
- 23 MR. PAVACIC: Exhibit P?
- 24 MR. TVERDYY: Oh, P was the resolution
- I mentioned. 25

- 4 resolution.
- 5 MR. MILAZZO: I'll just note,
- and we'll leave it on the record, just 6

- 8 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: Oh, okay.
- 9 MR. ARMAND EAGAN: Do you know he's
- 10 dead?
- MR. MILAZZO: Yeah, he passed away. 11
- 12 He is deceased.
- 13 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: Okay.
- 14 MR. BARON: Mr. Scheyer passed away.
- CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: Is that --15
- 16 we just mentioned that --
- 17 MR. MILAZZO: Yeah, we just noted
- 18 that --
- 19 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: -- for the
- 20 record.
- 21 MR. MILAZZO: -- and we send our
- 22 condolences to his family.
- MR. BARON: It's very sad. 23
- 24 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: Are we
- 25 ready to hear from the applicant?

- 8 So Mr. Eagan, you're just you're --
- 9 you were working with him; right?
- 10 MR. ARMAND EAGAN: I answer phones and

- 14 apparently make public presentations as well.

- 11 first precedent is the Woodstock application.
- 12 This application is identically similarly
- 13 situated with the current application, and was
- 14 declared by the director of the PBC Commission
- 15 at the time substantially similar to a road
- front parcel --16
- 17 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: Mr. Eagan,
- 18 do you have new exhibits you'd like to share
- 19 for this hearing?
- 20 MR. ARMAND EAGAN: I --
- 21 MR. MILAZZO: Well, I thought you
- 22 wanted it --
- 23 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: I just
- 2.4 wanted to check.
- 25 MR. ARMAND EAGAN: Yeah.

- 10 MR. MILAZZO: Okay. Thank you.
- 11 MR. BARON: We'd like to offer what is
- 12 previously marked as -- as exhibit as a part of
- 13 Exhibit C --
- 14 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: Previously
- 15 marked as Exhibit C for what? We have no
- 16 exhibits in front of us for this hearing.
- 17 MR. BARON: Understood.
- 18 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: Correct?
- 19 MR. BARON: We're now marking as
- Exhibit A, thank you. 20
- 21 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: Okay. So
- 22 you're going to provide us with --
- 23 MR. BARON: One copy --
- 24 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: --
- 25 exhibits for this hearing?

- MR. BARON: Yes, we only have one. 2
- 3 But did you want us to make multiple copies or
- 4 do you just need --
- 5 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: We need --

- 9 record --

- MR. BARON: Yes. For the purposes of 15
- 16 today's second hearing, which we'll go through
- 17 now, we're offering an Exhibit A, which is also
- 18 on the enlargement on the board right here
- 19 (indicating).
- 20 (Whereupon, a Brookhaven Tax Map
- 21 Section 529, Eagan Exhibit A was received
- 22 in evidence as of this date.)
- 23 MR. BARON: So this is --
- 24 MR. MILAZZO: So it'll be Eagan A.
- 25 MR. BARON: -- Eagan A. Thank you.

- 2 MR. MILAZZO: And that's, you want to
- 3 describe it? It's the section of the tax map.
- 4 MR. ARMAND EAGAN: It's a filed map
- with the Madelung parcel highlighted, the 5
- 6 Woodstock parcel highlighted, and the Dittmer
- 7 parcel highlighted. And that's on the
- 8 Section 5 -- Map 529 of Brookhaven.
- 9 MR. MILAZZO: Thank you.
- 10 MR. BARON: Give me one second.
- 11 (Whereupon, a discussion was held off
- 12 the record.)
- 13 MR. ARMAND EAGAN: And so Exhibit --
- 14 MR. BARON: Back on the record.
- 15 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: Okay.
- 16 (Whereupon, a Doris Fichter
- 17 Resolution, Eagan Exhibit B was received
- 18 in evidence as of this date.)
- 19 MR. ARMAND EAGAN: And this is
- 20 Exhibit B.
- 21 MR. MILAZZO: So that's Exhibit B?
- 22 MR. BARON: B.
- 23 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: Exhibit B,
- 24 okay.
- 25 And what is Exhibit B?

- 1 PROCEEDINGS
- 2 MR. MILAZZO: So --
- 3 MR. BARON: Exhibit B is -- Exhibit B
- 4 is what?
- 5 MR. ARMAND EAGAN: Exhibit B is the
- 6 Doris Fichter resolution dated --
- 7 MR. BARON: Dated August 5th, of '98.
- MR. ARMAND EAGAN: Are we -- we're 8
- 9 back on the record.
- 10 MR. MILAZZO: We're going to go back
- 11 on the record. Are you good? We're good.
- 12 Let's go.
- 13 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: So that's
- 14 Exhibit B.
- 15 MR. MILAZZO: We're back on the
- 16 record.
- 17 MR. ARMAND EAGAN: Exhibit B
- 18 August 5th, 1988 is a Doris Fichter Resolution
- 19 regarding a Credit matter.
- 20 MR. BARON: By the Pine Barrens.
- 21 MR. ARMAND EAGAN: By the Pine
- 22 Barrens. And Exhibit A is a copy of a file
- 23 map, a copy of the -- the map 529 with
- 24 highlighted Madelung, Woodstock and the
- 25 subjects of this appeal today.

- 1 PROCEEDINGS
- 2 So those are A and B.
- 3 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: So those
- 4 are the two exhibits for today's, for this
- 5 hearing?
- 6 MR. BARON: For this hearing.
- 7 CHAIRWOMAN MEEK GALLAGHER: Okav.
- 8 MR. ARMAND EAGAN: Okay -- okay,
- 9 Woodstock is identically similarly situated.
- 10 It was granted a full Credit. It was
- substantially similar to a road front parcel in 11
- 12 the words of Ray Kerwin (phonetic). The prior
- 13 approvals don't matter under the Act, but it
- 14 did qualify for a 280A road opening and a
- 15 building permit prior to the Act.
- 16 And then here's a second one. It was
- 17 Doris Fichter. In the application of Doris
- 18 Fichter, it was alleged that for lot 19, among
- 19 others, was single and separate. Lot 19 is
- 20 located within 350 feet away from an improved
- 21 road and needs similar variances in order to
- 22 be -- for a house to be built on the property,
- 23 and was granted one full PBC for following
- 2.4 reasons:
- 25 Parcel's proximity to an improved

- 2 road:
- 3 And the parcel's --
- 4 MR. MILAZZO: Mr. Eagan, I'm not
- 5 interrupting -- I am interrupting you only
- because if you go really fast, the stenographer 6
- 7 can't record everything.
- 8 MR. ARMAND EAGAN: Okay.
- 9 MR. MILAZZO: I'm not telling you how
- 10 to do your job, but I'm just offering that
- 11 piece of friendly advice. It's not even
- 12 advice, just --
- 13 MR. ARMAND EAGAN: I hear you. Thank
- you. Okay, I'm sorry. 14
- 15 MR. MILAZZO: I won't advise you at
- 16 all.
- 17 MR. ARMAND EAGAN: Let's -- let's
- 18 start that over again.
- 19 MR. MILAZZO: Okay.
- 20 MR. ARMAND EAGAN: Doris Fichter
- 21 application, Exhibit B. In this application,
- 22 it is alleged that lot 19, among others, was
- 23 single and separate. Lot 19 is located over
- 24 350 feet away from improved roads and --
- 25 You okay?

- 1 PROCEEDINGS
- 2 THE STENOGRAPHER: Yes.
- 3 MR. ARMAND EAGAN: And needs similar
- variances in order for a house to be built on 4
- 5 the property. The property was granted one
- full PBC for the following reasons: 6
- 7 According to the resolution, one, the
- 8 parcel's proximity to an improved road;
- 9 And two, the parcel's proximity to
- utilities. 10
- And I would like to remind the 11
- 12 Commission that -- are you okay.
- 13 THE STENOGRAPHER: Yes.
- 14 MR. ARMAND EAGAN: I don't know --
- 15 I'll let you catch up.
- All right, it's -- it's --16
- 17 MR. BARON: Go slower.
- MR. ARMAND EAGAN: -- it -- it is --18
- 19 it is -- we should tape record these too.
- 20 It is important to keep in
- 21 consideration that both for the purpose of
- 22 computing the allocation of PBCs, Pine Barren
- 23 Credits, a parcel of land is defined as a
- 24 separately assessed Suffolk County Real
- 25 Property Tax Parcel. See CLUP 6.3 and the

- PROCEEDINGS 1
- 2 Tuccio versus Pine Barrens Case in -- I think
- 3 in 2011, I think it was. The '11 case in the
- Second Department, they decided that they --4
- 5 for -- for the purpose of computing the
- allocation, it's defined as a single and 6
- 7 separately assessed tax parcel, as
- 8 substantially in this case. That's all.
- 9 MR. BARON: Can we just have one
- 10 moment?
- 11 (Whereupon, a discussion was held off
- 12 the record.)

- 17 MR. MILAZZO: And Mr. Eagan, I'm --
- I'm just -- on this parcel, who are -- do you 18
