Whereas, on October 20, 1995, Joseph Gazza submitted a Core Preservation Area hardship exemption application to clear the remaining native vegetation of a 6.57 acre parcel for a proposed agricultural use; and,

Whereas, on November 9, 1995, pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") Part 617.6, the Commission coordinated lead agency review; and,

Whereas, on December 6, 1995 a public hearing on the Core Preservation Area hardship was held by the Commission and the applicant gave an extension of the time in which to make a SEQRA determination and to issue a decision on the application and a transcript was thereafter made available to the Commission; and,

Whereas, on December 29, 1995, a staff report was issued to the Commission which was amended and accepted by the Commission at their meeting of Janaury 3, 1996; and,

Whereas, the Commission has considered the staff report and all materials submitted in connection with the Core Preservation Area hardship exemption; and,

Whereas, pursuant to a resolution passed at the Commission meeting of February 21, 1996, the Commission designated itself as lead agency and determined that the proposed action may have a significant impact on the environment pursuant to SEQRA; now therefore be it

Resolved, that the Commission hereby determines that the application, as submitted, does not meet all of the requirements for extraordinary hardship pursuant to New York State Environmental Conservation Law 57-0121 (10)(c) and be it further

Resolved, that the application for a Core Preservation Area hardship exemption is denied without predjudice.
