Whereas, on June 14, 2001, IGHL, c/o Frank Lombardi, filed with the Commission a request for a core preservation area hardship exemption to construct a 4500 sq. ft. Individualized Residential Alternative, on a 1.0 acre parcel situated in an A-5 Residence zoning district; and

Whereas, a public hearing on the application was held by the Commission on August 8, 2001 and a transcript was thereafter made available to the Commission; and

Whereas, pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act and regulations promulgated thereunder ("SEQRA"), the Commission conducted an uncoordinated review of the application as an unlisted action; and

Whereas, the Commission has considered all materials submitted in connection with the application; now therefore be it

Resolved, that the Commission hereby determines that the proposed action will not have a significant impact on the environment pursuant to SEQRA; and, be it further

Resolved, that the Commission hereby determines that the application and accompanying information, as submitted, does not meet the criteria for a Core Preservation Area hardship exemption pursuant to New York State Environmental Conservation Law Article 57-0121 (10); and be it further

Resolved, that the application for a Core Preservation Area hardship exemption is hereby denied.
