**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT YOU MAY BE IN VIOLATION** of New York State Environmental Conservation Law Article 57 in that you may have conducted development consisting of the removal of trees and other vegetation on property in the Core Preservation Area in a manner that constitutes "development" as defined by ECL Article 57 without having obtained the approval of the Central Pine Barrens Joint Planning and Policy Commission.

The aforementioned violations are alleged to have occurred on the property known as Peconic River Herb Farm owned by Christina Spindler and identified by Suffolk County Tax Map Number 600-144-1-27.6 and located at 2479 River Road, in the hamlet of Calverton, Town of Riverhead, County of Suffolk, State of New York.

Please take action to ensure that the above referenced activities cease immediately.

The above alleged violations may be punishable by the penalties set forth in Environmental Conservation Law §57-0136. Please contact John W.
