## Resolution on the Compatible Growth Area Application of U-Haul Mini-Storage Site Plan South side of Middle Country Road, 178' west of Mooney Pond Road Middle Island, Town of Brookhaven SCTM# 200-475-3-7

Whereas, U-Haul Corp., through their agent Steve Ferris, filed with the Commission an application for a site plan approval to construct a 29,631 square foot building for use as a mini-storage facility with parking for 149 cars on 3.95 acres and,

**Whereas**, pursuant to the New York Environmental Conservation Law Section 57-0121(9), applicant has obtained all necessary local and state approvals prior to petitioning the Commission, and,

Whereas, on or about July 10, 1995, the Town of Brookhaven Planning Board, pursuant to Article 8 of the New York Environmental Conservation Law ("SEQRA"), declared itself Lead Agency, issued a Determination of Non-Significance and a conditional site plan approval for the project, and,

Whereas, pursuant to a staff report issued on August 21, 1995, the Commission required the applicant to amend the site plan to be in conformance with the 15% limit on fertilized vegetation, and,

**Whereas**, a public hearing on the compatible growth area application was held by the Commission on August 23, 1995, and a transcript was thereafter made available to the Commission, and

Whereas, the Commission has considered the application and related documents, including the SEQRA materials, now therefore be it

**Resolved,** that the Commission determines that the application meets all requirements of the New York Environmental Conservation Law Section 57-0121(9), and

**Resolved**, that the project is consistent with the Commission's interim goals and standards as per the amended Site Plan prepared by Robert J. Gruber, Architect, entitled "U-Haul Mini-Storage" last revised September 20, 1995, and be it further

**Resolved** that the application is granted subject to the following condition:

1. That the applicant receive a revised approval from the Town of Brookhaven Planning Board and supply the Commission with a copy of same.
