**Whereas,** on April 21, 1997, Theodore Martz, through his agent Salvatore Malguarnera, filed with the Commission, a request for a core preservation area hardship exemption to construct one single family dwelling and associated sanitary system on a lot containing 18, 428 square feet, and,

**Whereas,** a public hearing on the core preservation hardship request was held by the Commission on May 14, 1997 and a transcript was thereafter made available to the Commission, and,

Whereas, the Commission has considered all materials submitted in connection with the application, now, therefore, be it

**Resolved,** pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") Part 617.5, the Commission hereby determines that the application is a Type II action, now therefore be it,

**Resolved,** that the Commission hereby determines that the application, as submitted does meet all of the requirements for extraordinary hardship pursuant to New York State Environmental Conservation Law 57-0121 (10)(a) and (c) and be it further

**Resolved,** that the application for a core preservation area hardship exemption is granted subject to the following condition:

- clearing of native vegetation shall not exceed 20% of the total lot area.
