Resolution on the Core Preservation Area Hardship Application of Seth Morgan

Properties located north of North Street, near its intersection with Ryerson Avenue, south of Peconic River County Park, Manorville, Town of Brookhaven SCTM # 200-410-1-7.6 & 10

Whereas, on March 11, 1997, Seth Morgan filed with the Commission, a request for a core preservation area hardship exemption to construct one single family dwelling and associated sanitary system on each of two lots containing approximately 7.1 and 7.8 acres respectively, and,

Whereas, a public hearing on the core preservation hardship request was held by the Commission on April 23, 1997 and a transcript was thereafter made available to the Commission, and,

Whereas, the Commission has considered all materials submitted in connection with the application, now, therefore, be it

Resolved, pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") Part 617.5, the Commission hereby determines that the application is a Type II action, now therefore be it

Resolved, that the Commission hereby determines that the application, as submitted does meet all of the requirements for extraordinary hardship pursuant to New York State Environmental Conservation Law 57-0121 (10)(a) and (c) and be it further

Resolved, that the application for a core preservation area hardship exemption is granted subject to the following conditions:

- 1. clearing of additional vegetation combined with the existing clearing shall not exceed 20% of the area of each lot.
- 2. receipt by the Commission of a document, satisfactory to Commission counsel, proving that there is legal access for lot 10.
