Resolution on the Core Preservation Area Hardship Application of John J. Feore Property located west side of Halsey Manor Road, north of CR 111, Manorville, Town of Brookhaven. SCTM # 200-462-4-7

Whereas, on August 26, 1996 John J. Feore, through his attorney Peter S. Danowski, Jr., filed with the Commission a request for a Core Preservation Area hardship exemption to build a single family house and associated septic system on 49,929 square feet, and,

Whereas, pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") Part 617.5, the Commission determined the application to be a Type II action, and,

Whereas, a public hearing on the Core Preservation Area hardship request was held by the Commission on August 21, 1996, and a transcript was thereafter made available to the Commission, and,

Whereas, pursuant to the public hearing the Commission requested additional information, and

Whereas, the Commission has considered all materials submitted in connection with the application, now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Commission hearby determines that the application, as submitted, does meet all of the requirements for extraordinary hardship pursuant to New York State Environmental Conservation Law 57-0121 (10)(a)(c) and be it further

Resolved, that the application for a Core Peservation Area hardship exemption is granted subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Clearing on the site be limited to 35% or of the entire parcel.
- 2. A maximum of 15% of the site be placed in fertilized vegetation.
- 3. The non-disturbance area is to be shown on the survey and shall be clearly marked in the field and protected during all phases of construction and thereafter. (*please provide this office with a copy of the revised survey*)
