## Resolution on the Core Preservation Area Hardship Application of Regina and Stanley Seltzer Property located north side of South River Road west of Edwards Avenue, Calverton, Town of Brookhaven. SCTM # 200-299-1-8

**Whereas,** on December 12, 1995 Regina and Stanley Seltzer filed with the Commission a request for a Core Preservation Area hardship exemption to build a single family house on 35,690 square feet, and,

**Whereas,** pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") Part 617.6, the Commission determined the application to be a Type II action, and,

**Whereas**, a public hearing on the Core Preservation Area hardship request was held by the Commission on Janaury 24, 1996, and a transcript was thereafter made available to the Commission, and,

**Whereas**, pursuant to the public hearing the Commission requested additional information including a survey of the subject property, and

**Whereas,** at their meetings of February 7, 1996 and March 6, 1996 the Commission accepted extensions on the time in which to render a decision on the subject application, now, therefore, be it

Whereas, the Commission has considered all materials submitted in connection with the application, now, therefore, be it

**Resolved,** that the Commission hearby determines that the application, as submitted, does meet all of the requirements for extraordinary hardship pursuant to New York State Environmental Conservation Law 57-0121 (10)(a)(c) and be it further

**Resolved**, that the application for a Core Peservation Area hardship exemption is granted subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Clearing on the site be limited to 35% or of the entire parcel.
- 2. The wetland edge be clearly delineated on the survey and in the field and protected with a 100' minimum non-disturbance buffer to be flagged in the field prior to construction.
- 3. A maximum of 15% of the site be placed in fertilized vegetation.
